WEEKDAY SCHOOL BEHAVIOR GUIDELINES

Being attentive to God's Word is a big part of learning. The Bible refers to it on many occasions (Proverbs 3:1, 3:7 and 16:2). It is important that each child learns to listen and to follow directions in order to prepare for successful learning in the future.

The following guidelines are:

1. Listen when others are speaking.
2. Follow directions the first time they are given.
3. Respect others' property.
4. Keep hands and feet to oneself.
5. Speak politely to others.

If a child is unable to follow these guidelines the consequences are as follows:

1. The teacher will re-direct their play or activity.
2. A verbal warning will be given.
3. If problem persists a "time out" will be given (separated from class activity, one minute per each year of age.)
4. If problem continues to persist, the teacher will inform the parents about the behavior requesting help with the problem.
5. If the child is beyond the teacher's control and is disruptive to the class the child will then be sent to the Director's Office. Again, the teacher will inform the parents about the behavior.
6. If problems continue, the child may be sent home from school (Director's discretion).

Children who follow these guidelines will, on occasion, be rewarded with:

1. Verbal praise.
2. Stickers/stamps to be given.
3. Special privileges from the teacher.
